TRASH PICK UP

Mondays and Thursdays pick up will start at 8:30 A.m. The gate will be open at 10 A.M - 12 P.M. To access the non-burnable area use the driveway that goes to the burnbox, not the entrance by the main road.

Please have your trash properly ready if you want IVC to continue picking up your trash. We kindly ask our customers to flatten boxes, make sure the trash bags are tied tightly, and make sure your trash is easily accessable. We will no longer be knocking on your doors to pick up trash. Thanks for understanding!

Grant Reports

IGAP: The IVC workers have been busy cleaning/clearing the area for our new building.

IVC recycles aluminum pop/beer/energy drink cans. For every trash bag full of cans you turn in, you will get one entry for our monthly \$25.00 giveaway.

We will be doing a Resilience survey this month. If you complete the survey, you will receive a \$25.00 gift card.

OVC: We will be distributing local medicinal plants this month. If you or a local elder you know has cultural knowledge they would like to pass on (storytelling, teaching traditional crafts, traditional foods/medicine) you can be compensated for sharing your knowledge or teaching a class. If you are interested, please contact our office.

ICWA: We received the new LI-HEAP/BBNA (heating assistance) applications at our office. BBNA will start accepting applications starting October 1st and they will start processing them November 1st, if you want to get yours in ASAP contact us for an application.

CULTURAL: Brenda's 'communities teaching cultures' program through the school district is ending this month, however the kids will be getting dream catchers and beading kits through this program when they come in. We can transition our cultural program and continue through our OVC grant.

COVID-19 Updates

Local tribal members have received additional assistance with their electric bill and heating fuel. This will be the last month we will deliver foodbank. We are waiting on more cleaning supplies, when they arrive we will deliver them.

Pumpkin Cheesecake Roll



Ingredients

- ¼ cup powdered sugar (sprinkle on towel)
- 3/4 cup all-purpose flour
- ½ tsp baking powder
- ½ tsp salt
- 3 large eggs
- 1 cup sugar
- 2/3 cup Libby's 100% pure pumpkin
- 1 package cream cheese (8 oz)
- 1 cup powdered sugar
- 6 tbsp butter or margarine
- 1 tsp vanilla extract

Instructions

- Preheat oven to 375 F. Grease 15 x 10inch pan; line with wax paper. Grease and flour paper. Sprinkle a thin, cotton kitchen towel with ½ cup powdered sugar.
- Combine flour, baking powder, baking soda, cinnamon, and salt in a small bowl. Beat eggs and sugar in large mixer bowl until thick. Beat in pumpkin. Stir in flour mixture. Spread evenly into pan.
- Bake for 13 to 15 minutes or until top cake springs back when touched.
 Carefully peel off paper. Roll up cake and towel together, starting with narrow end. Cool on wire rack.
- Beat cream cheese, powdered sugar, butter and vanilla extract in a mixer bowl until smooth. Carefully unroll cake. Spread cream cheese, refrigerate for 1 hour. Enjoy!
